ADVICE FOR SURVIVAL IN THE PRESENT CASHLESS NIGERIA


Events in the last few weeks have shown that the society has gradually moved into an era of cashless society where it is becoming almost impossible to handle raw cash in the transaction of any business. From indications, there may be no reversal of this development whereby the society may return to the era of use of cash in all commercial transactions as was the case before now. Consequently, it has become necessary to offer the following advice to students to avoid sliding into difficult situations as experienced recently where most students found it difficult even to purchase food on Campus.

Students are hereby advised to encourage their parents to open bank accounts and obtain debit cards (ATM Cards) for them. They should also remind their parents to deposit enough money in their accounts with which to use in Point of Sale (POS) services when they wish to make purchases. Students are already aware of the POS Services offered on Campus by the Bursary Department and are hereby encouraged to continue using same.

In the alternative, students also have the choice of depositing some money with the Bursary Department. Having made such deposits, students can buy meal coupons from the Bursary Department, present them to the Cafeteria and the cost of the meals debited from their accounts with the Bursary.

Students are by this circular advised to choose any of the above means of transactions on Campus in order to survive the cashless society the country has slid into and also avoid unnecessary suffering.
